To follow please find the necessary requirements for all mares visiting stallions at Gilltown Stud during the **2025 covering season**

NEGATIVE E.I.A. CERTIFICATE

All mares should have one negative E.I.A. certificate from an approved Irish or UK Laboratory taken on or after January 1st, 2025.

NEGATIVE C.E.M. CERTIFICATE

Dated after January 1st, 2025 from a recognised Irish or UK laboratory stating that the mare is negative for: Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM) Klebsiella Pseudomonas

E.V.A.Equine Viral Arteritis

NEGATIVE E.V.A. CERTIFICATE

All mares should have one negative E.V.A. certificate from an approved Irish or UK Laboratory taken on or after January 1st, 2025.



If the mare originates from outside of Ireland or England the test must be taken a minimum of 14 days after arrival in Ireland.



All mares imported from North American (USA & Canada) also require two negative clitoral swabs fossa & sinuses), taken after the 1st January 2025, at least seven days apart, and within 30 days of export.



If the mare originates from outside of Ireland or England the test must be taken a minimum of 14 days after arrival in Ireland.



PLEASE NOTE

NO MARE WILL BE COVERED unless the required EIA/EVA/CEM certificates, passport, proof of FLU vaccinations and signed contract are provided in advance of her arrival in the covering shed.



DOURINE TEST

Mares arriving from Italy and mares which have been in Italy since January 1st, 2012, require a negative blood test for Dourine taken a minimum of 14 days after arrival in Ireland.

Please ensure the person / boarding farm responsible for the day-to-day care of your mare is aware of the above requirements
